

Making the Squares

A complete set of squares consists of five envelopes containing pieces of cardboard which have been cut

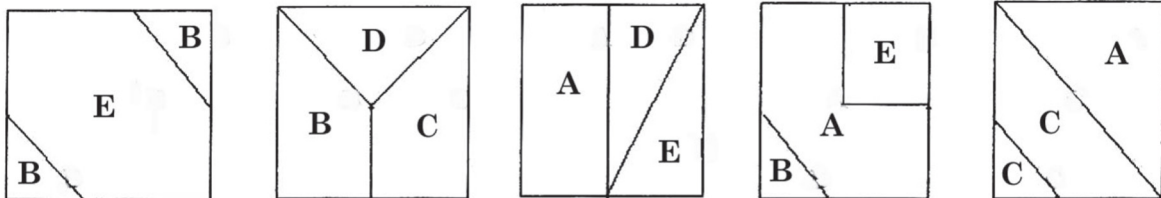
into different patterns and which, when properly assembled, form five squares of equal size. One set is

provided for each group.

To make a set, cut out five cardboard squares of equal size (about six by six inches). Mark the squares as

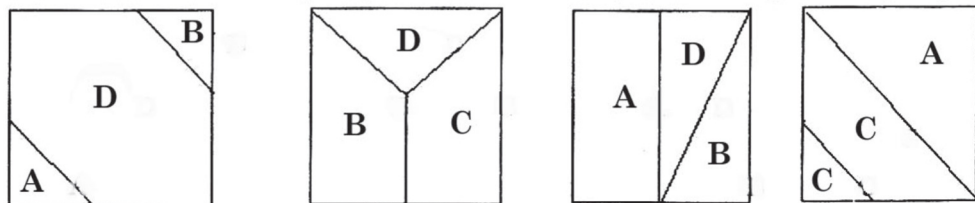
below.

Each square is 6 inches by 6 inches.



Alternate Layout

If you wish to make smaller groups, this alternate layout is designed for groups of 4



The lines should be drawn so that all pieces with the same shape will be exactly the same size. After

drawing the lines, cut each square into the smaller pieces that will make up the puzzle. Mark five envelopes

with the letters A, B, C, D, and E. Distribute the puzzle pieces in the envelopes.
